PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

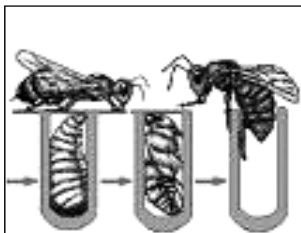
I would like to relate an observation that on the surface is very obvious but seems to amaze me every year. Throughout the summer my high school aged son James did not have to wake up at any particular time in the morning so I got to sleep till 6:45 am. In early September when his school started he needed to get up by 6:00 am and therefore so did I. My bedroom window faces east so each morning I was awakened by the alarm and the sun. As September rolled into October I was blissfully unaware that each morning the sun was a little lower in the sky and did not brighten my room as it did the previous day. Unbelievably one morning as I turned the alarm off I realized my bedroom was completely dark. I made a double take at the alarm clock to make sure it was 6:00 am and it was. Painfully I had to acknowledge that summer has passed into fall.

Now that fall is upon us I think it necessary to remind all beekeepers to make another round of checks of your bee hives. While mites should not be a concern now as long as you treated in August/September you need to check for queen rightness and honey stores. Queenless hives should be combined with a strong hive and so should weak hives be combined with strong hives. Queenless and weak hives could be invaded by wax moth which is a mess. Hives low on winter stores can be helped greatly by feeding a thick sugar syrup. 50 lbs of granulated sugar makes 6 gallons of thick sugar syrup. The cost of 50 lbs of granulated is about \$30 but could add up to 45 lbs of winter stores. \$30 is much cheaper than the \$90-\$125 to replace the bees in spring. Let's not be penny wise and dollar foolish.

Our October 26 meeting at the Eco Complex is very important for two reasons. Number one it is our first attempt at a live video program or webinar. Our guest speaker will be live from Alberta, Canada. We will also be able to interact with him as if he were in the room with us. While this technology is new for most members it has been used for some time in the business world. Due to its popularity and broad use the costs are unbelievably inexpensive. It is doubtful that we will spend even \$75 for the program. Remember the program starts at 7:00 pm! The business portion of the membership meeting will begin after the program. So do not be late!!!

The second important reason to be at the October 26 meeting, it is election time for the board members. If you care

about the direction of the CJBA you need to vote. Without your participation there is no CJBA.

Mead Making Workshop at the Ricci's

Date: November 10, 2012

Start: 9:30 AM ending at approximately 3 pm Location 55 Chesterfield Arneytown Rd, Allentown, NJ 08501

Cost: \$10 per participant, collected that morning or 7\$ to cover the cost of the refreshments for those not planning to bring home mead.



Description: We will be making mead in two 15 gallon batches. At the end of the day participants will bring home a gallon jug of semi-sweet mead must, which they allow to ferment and bottle on their own. Each gallon will yield 4 to 5 bottles of finished mead. This will allow up to 30 people To bring home a gallon of mead each.

Supplies: We'll be supplying the yeast, nutrient, bubblers corks, pots, stoves and handouts with instructions on how to get your mead finished and bottled.

Participants will need to bring their own Glass Gallon jug, 3lbs honey, and an optional folding chair. I do have a few gallon jugs available for those who can't find one.

Note: Anyone who wants to make more than a gallon will need to let me know ahead of time, and bring a quart of honey for each gallon they plan to make. I have enough equipment to make up to 30 gallons of mead must. Depending on how many people sign up, those wanting to make larger batches for themselves may have to bring their own propane, burner and pot along with a container to bring it home in..

Refreshments: We will have coffee and donuts starting at 9:30 am, and bottled water and soft drinks for the rest of the day. You can bring your own lunch or we'll be taking up a collection for those who want to order hoagies from a local deli, or Pizza.

Rain Plans: We will have canopies set up in case of rain, but may need additional canopies depending on the turnout so please let me know if you have one that we might use.

OCT 26, FALL MEETING

The Central Jersey Beekeepers Association will be holding its fall meeting at the Rutgers Eco-Complex on October 26th. The guest speaker's presentation begins at 7:30 pm and the business part of the meeting will begin around 9:00pm; food and soda will be available at 7:00 p.m.



The speaker for the meeting will be Steve Pernal who is the head honeybee researcher for the Canadian government. What makes this meeting special is that in addition to Steve's unique perspective on the honeybee, he will be making his presentation from his office in Alberta, Canada using the Internet.

We think the way the presentation is being presented, via the Internet, warrants your attention. A matter of fact we are inviting all NJBA branch presidents, the NJBA president and our State Apiarist to our meeting. So the Central Jersey Beekeepers Association would like to invite you to our fall meeting so that you may participate in this unique presentation.

For this meeting the presentation technology is costing the CJBA \$0.42 a minute, so for a 1 ½ meeting our estimated presentation costs will be \$37.80. If we record the meeting the additional cost is \$0.06 a minute and if we want the meeting archived and available on the internet for members who missed the original meeting the cost would be \$12.00 a month.

This past Thursday we conducted a 25-minute test of the technology at the Rutgers EcoComplex – Steve Pernal made his presentation from Canada and Laurie Magee from the Eco-Complex fine tuned their equipment- and the test was a 100% success.

Now here is where this presentation technology potential gets interesting:

- Multiple sites could participate in the same meeting at \$0.21 a minute for each multiple site
- Large one-site meetings could use this presentation technology to offer secondary and tertiary speakers
- Important presentations can be archived and then viewed via the internet by members who could not make the original meeting

We are approaching the October 26 as a second test but on a larger scale with a live audience. We hope you can make it.

RECIPES

Honey Citrus Soother

Place tea bags and cinnamon stick in a 1-quart tea pot. Add boiling water; steep 3 to 5 minutes. Remove cinnamon stick and tea bags; discard. Stir in grapefruit juice and honey.



YIELD: 4 SERVINGS
Ingredients

- 3 - tea bags green or black
- 1 - cinnamon stick
- 3 cups - boiling water
- 1/4 cup - honey
- 1 cup - grapefruit juice

Directions

Place tea bags and cinnamon stick in a 1-quart tea pot. Add boiling water; steep 3 to 5 minutes. Remove cinnamon stick and tea bags; discard. Stir in grapefruit juice and honey.

Mom's Rejuvenating Honey-Almond Scrub

Process almonds and oats in a blender until they are finely ground. In a small bowl, mix ground almonds and oats, honey and yogurt until blended. Pat scrub on face and neck; leave it on for up to 10 minutes for extra softening. Wet your hands and massage gently to exfoliate. Rinse off. Makes enough for 1 scrub.

Yield: 1 Scrub

Ingredients

- 8 whole - unblanched almonds
- 2 tablespoons - rolled oats, uncooked
- 1 tablespoon - honey
- 2 teaspoons - yogurt, sour cream, or lightly beaten egg white



Directions

Process almonds and oats in a blender until they are finely ground. In a small bowl, mix ground almonds and oats, honey and yogurt until blended. Pat scrub on face and neck; leave it on for up to 10 minutes for extra softening. Wet your hands and massage gently to exfoliate. Rinse off. Makes enough for 1 scrub
